

Tri County Driving School of Deer Park

Session begins September 17

Session finishes October 26

Classes are held in F 106 at Deer Park High School from 3:00 to 5:00pm. Week 1: Monday thru Friday, then classes will be two times a week there after usually on Monday and Tuesday.

Drive times will be scheduled weekly in 2 hour blocks where each student drives 1 hour and observes 1 hour, outside of class time.

Cost of the class is \$ 440.00, or payment plan of \$ 465.00. A minimum of \$200.00 is required down for the payment plan. All payment must be completed by Tuesday October 9th.

Parent Night is Tuesday, September 18th at 5:00 in the theater immediately after class. This is a mandatory meeting required by the state.

Answer's to most often asked questions:

How old do I have to be to take the class? 15 years old on or before the first day of class.

What do I need to get a learner's permit? Go to (dol.wa.gov) steps to getting a license, then instruction permit, then pre-apply online, then join now, then go to pre-apply and get my first Washington drivers permit, and follow the steps. Do this before class starts and bring your identification number to class. When you bring your identification number to class and make a payment to enroll we will enter that number into the DOL data base, and then you can go to the DOL to get your learner's permit. If you already have a Washington Identification Card you do not need to get another number online.

Do I need any books? Yes get a copy of the Drivers Guide Booklet at the Department of Licensing when you get your permit, or download a copy from (dol.wa.gov)

How many classes and how many drives do I need to complete? 17 classes and 5 drives.

Who do I make checks payable to? Tri County Driving School. **We do not accept debt or credit cards.**

If I am making payments when is the final payment due? Tuesday October 9th.
