Class of 2022 - Graduation Agreement Form

Graduation Ceremonies:

If students fulfill graduation requirements by the end of the last term of their senior year, they may participate in graduation ceremonies. Each student shall be awarded a diploma after satisfactorily completing local and state requirements. **Upon request**, each graduating student shall receive a final transcript. Transcripts can be requested by contacting Amy Foley in the Counseling Center or via email at amy.foley@dpsdmail.org. Each student shall be notified of this opportunity at least one month prior to the close of the school term. Additionally, by signing this form you hereby consent to have your student's likeness published in various media to include: newspaper articles, TV, radio broadcasts, websites, newsletters, DVDs, and video broadcasts. *Video (with sound) is typically broadcasted (live during the graduation ceremony) and uploaded to YouTube for public viewing.*

Graduation Ceremonies will be conducted in the following manner:

- A. Each participating student **must** participate in the graduation ceremony rehearsal. Each student will purchase the proper cap/gown/tassel and DPHS medallion unit as designated by DPHS. Any student not able to purchase the designated attire may borrow from the DPHS Lending Closet (when supply is available).
- B. Caps and gowns will be worn in the proper manner, as designated by school administration and class advisor.
- C. Male students will wear full-length slacks (preferred) or jeans (no torn or frayed). **NO SHORTS!** Appropriate shirts must be worn. Girls may wear dresses. Boys must wear shoes with socks. Girls may wear dress sandals. **Flip flops will not be permitted.**
- D. Each student who participates will be expected to cooperate with the class advisor and to participate in all parts of the graduation ceremonies.
- E. Artificial Noise-Makers will not be allowed in the gym. This includes, but is not limited to air-horns, whistles and sirens. Each student is responsible for informing their guests of our "No Artificial Noise-Maker" policy.
- F. **Seniors must have their fines/fees paid in full in order to receive their diploma following graduation. Fines/fees must be paid to our Cashier, Leah Kronich during regular school hours. Fine/fee money will not be accepted on the day of graduation, nor after 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 10th (the day before graduation).**
- G. Failure to comply with the requirements will automatically forfeit a student's privilege of participation in the graduation ceremonies.

I have read and agree to follow the above policies. Failure to abide by these rules will forfeit my participation in the 2022 Graduation Ceremony.
